

# Guidelines for Poster Display Competition

## Objective

The primary objective of the competition is to provide participants with a platform to present their research, ideas, or creative work in a visually engaging format.

## Participation

- The participants must be the undergraduate students of *nec*.
- The team must register online for participation.
- Team size: 1-4 members.

## General Rules

- **Template** will be provided later.
- **Size:** Create your poster of size 36x48 inches.
- **Title:** Provide a clear and concise title that reflects the main focus of your poster.
- **Content Organization:** Organize your poster into sections, such as Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion. Ensure a logical flow of information.
- **Visual Appeal:** Utilize high-quality images, charts, graphs, and illustrations to enhance the visual appeal of your poster.
- **Font and Text:** Use readable fonts with appropriate sizes. The title should be larger of font size 70 points and bold, headings of 44 points and bold), and body text of 36 points.
- **Concise Text:** Keep the text brief and to the point. Use bullet points, keywords, and short sentences to convey information effectively.
- **Color Scheme:** Maintain a consistent color scheme throughout the poster. Use no more than 2-3 colors.
- **White Space:** Leave sufficient white space to avoid overcrowding and provide a balanced layout.
- **Language:** Ensure that the content is written in clear and concise language suitable for the target audience.
- **Originality and Plagiarism:** Your poster should be an original work created by you or your team.
- **Presentation:** During the competition, stand beside your poster and be prepared to present and explain your work to judges and visitors.
- **Judging Criteria:** The judges will evaluate your poster based on the clarity of message, visual impact, organization, and scientific merit.
- **Template:** The poster must fit in the template that will be provided later.
- The evaluation team will decide the winner of the competition.

## Awards

- Winner will be awarded NRs. 10,000/-
- First Runner Up will be awarded NRs. 5,000/-

- Other participants will get Certificate of Participation.
